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**DECISION:**

To approve the making of a Direction under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 in respect of operations and development at land at Bylands Meadow, rear of Bylands House, off Dunstable Road, Redbourn.

In arriving at my decision I have properly and thoroughly taken into account the legal, financial and workforce implications for the Council. My decision is within the Council’s policy and budget framework and complies with the regulations and procedures set out in the Constitution. I have explicitly considered the Council’s corporate objectives in arriving at my decision. In coming to my decision I have consulted with all relevant parties as appropriate and in accordance with the scheme of delegation.

**REASON/S FOR THE DECISION**

The basis for this decision is that the Council has received information that plots of agricultural land within the Metropolitan Green Belt at Bylands Meadow are being offered for sale as investment land. There is concern that prospective purchasers may wish the plots to be divided by some form of enclosure, which would have an adverse impact on the rural openness, character and appearance of the Green Belt. There have been several previous instances on other sites in the district where land had been similarly marketed and Article 4 Directions have been served. It was recommended that an Article 4 Direction be served in respect of the land at Bylands Meadow, rear of Bylands House, off Dunstable Road, Redbourn removing permitted development rights for the erection, construction, maintenance, improvement or alteration of a gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure. The decision was taken by the Head of Paid Service in consultation with the Portfolio Holder and the Mayor as a matter of urgency as there was felt to be an immediate threat to the openness of the agricultural land within the Metropolitan Green Belt.
