Responsibility for Functions

	The functions listed in paragraphs 9 and 10 above will be exercised by the Cabinet only to the extent necessary in respect of actions which are preliminary to the exercise of powers to make compulsory purchase orders. In all other cases these functions will be exercised by the Council through delegated powers described above.
