Street Festival celebrates the heritage and history of St Albans City and District. Concluding the Alban Weekend, the Alban Street Festival has become a modern tradition, serving as the ending to festivities which can be traced back 1700 years.

However, the Alban Street Festival is as much about teaching and learning about our history as it is about celebrating our future; the City and District's culture and diversity, and the local communities from around the world who have chosen to make St Albans home.

St Albans Feastival

Every year we close St Peter's Street for the St Albans Feastival. We welcome over 15,000 people from around the country, who come to sample street food and artisan products from every corner of the globe, produced by over 115 traders and independent businesses present at the event. With stages providing live entertainment and cooking demonstrations from industry experts, there are many opportunities for sponsorship – to suit your organisation's requirements.

Food and Drink Awards

The St Albans Food and Drink Festival Awards provide an opportunity to **celebrate local indpendent businesses** in the District. Over **340 public nominations** across 8 categories are sent to 12-person panel of food experts, with winners announced at an awards evening.

Your business has the opportunity to become an awards event sponsor, or to sponsor one of our **8 award categories**. Categories include: Restaurant of the Year, Best Local Producer, Best Pub or Bar, and Best Newcomer, among others.







Christmas Cracker
