

How to use StreetLink

A Step-by-Step Guide

01 Sleeping rough or worried about someone who is?

StreetLink is there for anyone sleeping outside, bedding down, or sleeping somewhere not designed for habitation.

02 Describe their precise location

Use the map to pinpoint the exact location. Share important details like nearby road names, door numbers, landmarks, access information. Consider using [What3Words](#).

03 Describe the person

Describe what they're wearing, any personal belongings such as a sleeping bag, physical characteristics like tattoos or hair colour, and details about their welfare.

04 Submit your alert

Include contact details, pet information, and any safety concerns. Remember, every detail matters. You can request to receive an update within 10 working days.

05 What will happen next?

Once submitted, your alert is sent to the local outreach team. Remember, StreetLink itself does not provide accommodation or actively search for individuals sleeping rough.
