TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1988 (AS AMENDED)

THE DISTRICT OF ST. ALBANS, BEESONEND

ARTICLE 4(1) DIRECTION 1993.

WHEREAS the Council of the District of St. Albans being the appropriate Local Planning Authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions set out in the First Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land shown edged black on the plan annexed hereto and described in the Second Schedule hereto unless permission therefore is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers, conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the FIRST Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Development of the following Parts and Classes as described in Schedule 2 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988.

Part 1 Development within the curtilage of a dwelling house

CLASS A	The enlargement, improvement or other alteration of a dwelling house.
CLASS C	Any other alteration to the roof of a dwelling house (other than is provided for in Class B).
CLASS D	The erection or construction of a porch outside any external door of a dwelling house.
CLASE E	The provision within the curtilage of a dwelling house of any building or enclosure, swimming or other pool required for a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwelling house, or the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of such a building or enclosure.
CLASS F	The provision within the curtilage of a dwelling house of a hard surface for any purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwelling house.
CLASS G	The erection or provision within the curtilage of a dwelling house of a container for the storage of oil for domestic heating.
CLASS H	The installation, alteration or replacement of a satellite antenna on a dwelling house or within the curtilage of a dwelling house.

Being development comprised with Part 1 referred to in Schedule 2 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Part or Class.

Part 2 Minor operations

CLASS A	The erection, construction, maintenance, improvement or alteration of a gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure.
CLASS B	The formation, laying out and construction of a means of access to a highway which is not a trunk road or classified road, where that access is required in connection with development permitted by any class in Schedule 2 of the
Market State of the State of th	General Development Order (other than by Class A of Part 2).

CLASS C The painting of the exterior of any building or work.

Being development comprised within Part 2 referred to in Schedule 2 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Part or Class.

SECOND SCHEDULE

All that land and premises situate in Redbourn Parish embracing the following properties: Nos 1-6 Beesonend Cottages, more particularly shown edged in black on the plan annexed hereto.
