St Albans City and District Council's Parks and Green Spaces Team are once again running the District Schools in Bloom competition for 2022! This is now in its 9th year, and we are really pleased to be running the competition in partnership with Herts & Middlesex Wildlife Trust, Environment Agency, John O'Conner, Burston Garden Centre and Carpenters Nursery.

## Why take part in District Schools in Bloom 2022?

The District Schools in Bloom competition is aimed at schools within St Albans City and District that are delivering the KS1 and KS2 Curriculum. The competition will complement elements of the Curriculum and will support children with their learning and development.

The competition provides an opportunity for pupils to learn about the principles of gardening and to develop their gardening skills. All the categories in this competition are based on the themes of wildlife gardening and sustainability. This will help pupils to understand the vital role that gardens play in providing habitats and refuge for nature and wildlife, as well as the importance of maintaining these in a sustainable way. These wildlife havens are essential, especially in the face of habitat loss and fragmentation in the wider landscape, and also as climate change becomes more evident.

District Schools in Bloom has been very successful over the last eight years, even despite the Covid-19 restrictions over the last two years. It has been thoroughly enjoyed by all the children and teachers who have taken part.



#### How will the competition be run this year?

Due to the ongoing uncertainty with Covid-19, this year we have decided to run the competition in a hybrid format. This means that we will be offering a choice of in-person school visits to judge the entries (depending on Government regulations and your school preference), as well as the option to submit digital entries only.

Wildlife gardening is a great opportunity to help our local wildlife. Getting outdoors and engaging with nature is also essential for our health and wellbeing. So let's get gardening!

There are **SIX** categories to choose from, and you can enter as many of these categories as you wish!

Crafting Nature

Plant to Plate

Scrapyard Scarecrow

Super Sunflowers!

The Wilder Award! (\*NEW!\*) Water for Wildlife (\*NEW!\*)

This year, we will also be awarding a new **Sustainable School Award**, to the school that can demonstrate use of the most sustainable practices overall! Please encourage as many children as possible from your school to take part! We'd love for children to get outdoors and get gardening, both at school, and also at home if they are having to isolate.

#### The judging

This year, we are hoping to visit schools in person for judging at the beginning of July (depending on Government regulations and your school preference). If this is possible, then we will be in contact later in the year to confirm dates / times.

Please continue to take photos of all your entries in the event that school visits cannot take place in July.

However, for those that would still prefer just to submit digital entries, without an in-person school visit, we will still be accepting digital entries as well.

Please confirm your judging preferences (school visit or digital entries) when submitting your entry form.
