St Albans Warmer Homes



The St Albans Warmer Homes scheme is an energy efficiency initiative from St Albans City & District Council helping residents keep warm and reduce their fuel bills.

The scheme aims to help residents improve the energy efficiency of their homes by providing funding for a range of home improvements.

What is available in the scheme?

Eligible residents may be able to receive funding towards the install of:

- Cavity wall insulation
- Loft insulation
- Underfloor insulation
- External wall insulation
- A-rated boiler upgrades
- First-time central heating

How much funding is available?

Funding is sourced from the Government's long running Energy Company Obligation Scheme which may cover the full cost of the works in some circumstances.

The amount of funding residents can receive will depend on a survey of their property.

The Council will also seek additional sources of funding to help. The Older People's Trust, for instance, may assist certain homeowners over 60 who would otherwise be unable to afford a boiler upgrade. Those in receipt of Pension Guarantee Credit are likely to receive help.

Who is eligible?

Homeowners and private renting tenants in St Albans could receive funding if they qualify via one of the following routes:

Receive certain state benefits for example:

Pension Guarantee Credit, Income Based Job Seekers Allowance, Income Support, Working Tax Credit etc.

OR

Have a low income (under £20,000 after rent/mortgage payments) and:

- have children under 5
- are over 65
- are a pregnant women
- have certain health conditions (asthma, heart conditions *etc.*)
- live in a hard to heat home (poorly insulated, no central heating *etc.*)
