Housing

There are a range of housing options that are only accessible once you reach a certain age. The age requirements vary, but you often need to be at least 55 to be considered. Below are a range of housing options that you can contact.

Social Housing

Social Housing for older people is allocated through the council Housing Register. You need to be over 60 to be considered and need to have a local connection to the district. You will be able to apply for both sheltered accommodation managed by the Council as well as other sheltered units managed by local housing associations. Private Rented Elderly Persons Housing

There are various privately rented retirement schemes and care home in the area. Care homes general provide a package of support, as where retirement schemes are more focused on independent living, often with your own front door and only the support you require.
