- Q1 Are Policies SP13 and HW1-HW5 justified, effective and consistent with national policy?

- Q2 Is it sufficiently clear to users of the Plan when a Health Impact Assessment is required? Is Policy HW5 effective in this regard?
- 1.5 It is clear when a HIA is required but it is not necessary to set this out in a Local Plan policy. The types of development/ application that require a HIA would be better set out in a local validation list that can be more easily updated to reflect changing circumstances and provide additional details on the scope and purpose of a HIA. Policy HW5 could then focus on the policy objective of a HIA and requirement for significantly adverse impacts to be mitigated.

Issue 5 – Strategic Scale Development – Policy IMP1

- Q1 What is the justification for Policy IMP1? Does it establish planning policy, or set out validation requirements for planning applications?
- 1.6 Policy IMP1 sets out expectations around engagement on infrastructure capacity and provision that would form part of an infrastructure/ utilities statement to be submitted with planning applications for relevant developments. It is, in effect, setting the scope of such a document and could be included in a local validation list. Alternatively, it could be provided as guidance for the strategic scale site allocations/ Broad Locations set out at Part B of the Local Plan.
