Review of Parliamentary Polling Districts and Polling Places

Following the conclusion of the recent Local Government Boundary Commission for England Review, St Albans City and District Council ('The Council') is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places within its area.

The Council will assess the need for new or changed polling districts and polling places and may make recommendations in respect of the creation, alteration or deletion of polling districts and polling places.

The Acting Returning Officer is required to make representations to the Council, which must include information as to the location of polling stations within the existing and/or proposed polling places.

Any elector within the authority or within a parliamentary constituency which has any part in the authority may make a representation. Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places which may be used as polling places.

The Council would welcome any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any form of disability to make a representation or to comment on the Council's proposals, or any recommendation of the Acting Returning Officer.
