Step 3 - Capping the level of any increase

Where the relevant strategic policies for housing were adopted *more than 5 years* ago (at the point of making the calculation), the local housing need figure capped at 40% above whichever is the higher of:

- a. The projected household growth for the area over the 10 year period identified in step 1; or
- b. The average annual housing requirement figure set out in the most recently adopted strategic policies (if a figure exists)
- SADC average annual household growth over 10 years (2019 to 2029) is **640** (as per step 1)
- SADC minimum annual local housing need figure is **1,152** (as per step 2)
- The cap is set at 40% above the higher of the most recent average annual housing requirement figure or household growth:

$$Cap = 640 + (40\% \times 640)$$

$$Cap = 640 + 256$$

$$Cap = 896$$

The capped figure (896) is lower than the minimum annual local housing need figure (1,152) and therefore limits the increase to the local authority's minimum annual housing need figure. The minimum figure for SADC is therefore **896**.
