There do not appear to be a map of the polling districts for Hill End ward on the SADC website. 	<p>Thank you for your email. In answer to your questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alterations to district ward boundaries must be approved by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England (LGBCE). Following the completion of the current Community Governance Review of parish / town council boundaries, and subject to Council's approval on 7 December of the amendment to the Sandridge Parish Council boundary around Rose

				<p>Walk, we will be making a request to the LGBCE to amend the Marshalswick West / Marshalswick East & Jersey Farm district ward boundaries so that they're co-terminous with the parish boundary. Once that change has been considered and approved by the LGBCE, we'll be able to abolish polling district MWE and include 1-3 Rose Walk in polling district MEB. Due to the timescales and deadlines involved, this change is expected to take place after the 4 May 2023 elections.</p> <p>2. Thank you for bringing this to our attention.
