NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development in the area described in the Second Schedule hereto of the description set out in the First Schedule hereto

FIRST SCHEDULE

Any development of the kind specified in Paragraph I of Class II of the First Schedule to the said Order, viz: -

> The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure not exceeding 4 feet in height where abutting on a highway used by vehicular traffic or 7 feet in height in any other case, and the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure

SECOND SCHEDULE

ALL land and premises situate in the City of St. Albans and bounded on the North East by London Road, on the North West by Herons Way, on the South West by the Electrical Apparatus Company Playing Field and on the South East by Birklands College which said land contains an area of Twenty-one Acres or thereabouts and is known as The Whitecroft Estate all which said land and premises is more particularly delineated on the map annexed hereto and thereon edged with a thick black dotted line.




