

A memorial to remember those unmarked but not forgotten!

From the late 19th century and up until the mid-20th century a large amount of people could not afford the luxury of purchasing a private grave for their loved one. Instead, public graves were used and meant that a memorial was not permitted.

Earlier this year, a Remembrance Memorial was installed in the Hatfield Road Cemetery to give present-day families who know of a relative buried in a public grave the option of commemorating them on a plaque. A plaque can be leased in memory of anyone, whether they are buried in the cemetery or not.
