The Scheme will take effect from 1 April 2024 until 31 March 2025.

In making the Scheme, the Council had regard to recommendations from an independent remuneration panel in accordance with Regulation 19(1) of the Local Authorities (Members' Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003, as amended. The main features of the Scheme as adopted are as follows:

- (iii) Provision for Members of the Council to claim a childcare or dependent relatives' allowance of £10.42 per hour in recognition of the costs of care incurred while absent from home on Council business;
