#### THE ST ALBANS CITY AND DISTRICT COUNCIL (OLD RECTORY CLOSE, HARPENDEN)(RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES) **ORDER 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the St Albans City and District Council (pursuant to arrangement made with Hertfordshire County Council) has made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Orders will come into effect on 28th May 2018.

The general effect of the Orders would be to introduce waiting restrictions to improve road safety, reduce instances of inappropriate or inconsiderate parking and increase the available provision of resident parking places.
