

**THE ST ALBANS CITY AND DISTRICT COUNCIL (CHEQUER STREET, ST ALBANS)  
(DISABLED PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the St Albans City and District Council (pursuant to arrangement made with Hertfordshire County Council) has made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into effect on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2022.

The general effect of the Order would be to introduce disabled parking bays to improve the amenity of the road and its surroundings, provide suitable and adequate parking facilities for disabled blue badge holders and reduce instances of inappropriate or inconsiderate parking.

SCHEDULE

**Disabled Persons Parking Places At Any Time 3 Hour Maximum Stay No Return within 2 hours**

Chequer Street St Albans, Outside HSBC. As defined in the Traffic Regulation Order and accompanying map.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date of this Notice, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
