When we moved here there was a GP surgery. However, that closed some years ago and patients transferred to their Hatfield surgery.

If we didn't have a vehicle or God forbid something happened, we would be isolated.

There are insufficient places in the Infant and Junior School in the village. The Secondary Schools are also oversubscribed, and it is difficult to gain places in the schools of your choice.

There is no provision for over 50's who are not fit enough to walk or cycle and if we didn't have cars we couldn't live here.
