## **ENFORCEMENT NOTICE**

#### WHEREAS:-

- (1) It appears to the Council of the City and District of St.Albans "the Council"), being the local planning authority for the purposes of Section 172 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended by the Planning and Compensation Act 1991) ("the Act") in this matter, that there has been a breach of planning control within paragraph (a) of Section 171A(1) of the Act within the period of 4 years on the land or premises ("the land") described in Schedule 1 below.
- (2) The breach of planning control which appears to have taken place consists in the carrying out of development by the making of the material change in the use of the **building**, **engineering**, **mining** or **other operations** described in Schedule 2 below, without the grant of planning permission required for that development.
- (3) The Council consider it expedient, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to all other material considerations, to issue this Enforcement Notice, in exercise of their powers contained in the said Section 172, for the reasons set out in the annex to this Notice.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council require that the steps specified in Schedule 3 below be taken in order to remedy the breach within the period of 3 months from the date on which this Notice takes effect.

**THIS NOTICE SHALL TAKE EFFECT**, subject to the provisions of Section 175(4) of the Act, on 8 June 2009

### Steps required to be taken

Reduce the height of the fence to 1 metre where it is adjacent to a highway used by vehicular traffic.


