ENFORCEMENT NOTICE OPERATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Issued by: St Albans District Council

1. This Notice is issued by the council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. The Land To Which The Notice Relates

127 Oakwood Road Bricket Wood St. Albans Hertfordshire
Shown edged red on the attached plan.

3. The Matters Which Appear To Constitute The Breach Of Planning Control

It appears to the Council that the following breach of planning control has occurred within the last 4 years.

Erection of single storey rear extension attached to ground floor premises at 127 Oakwood Road Bricket Wood (shown edged blue on the attached plan.)

4. Reasons For Issuing This Notice

By reason of its poor design quality and non matching materials, the rear single storey structure is a visually intrusive form of development and is detrimental to the character and appearance of the building and general locality, thereby contrary to Policy 69 (General Design and Layout) of the St.Albans District Local Plan Review 1994

5. What You Are Required To Do

Remove the single storey structure from the rear of the building.

Make good in matching materials.

6. Time For Compliance


3 months after this notice takes effect.

7. When This Notice Takes Effect

This notice takes effect on 6 January 2012 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

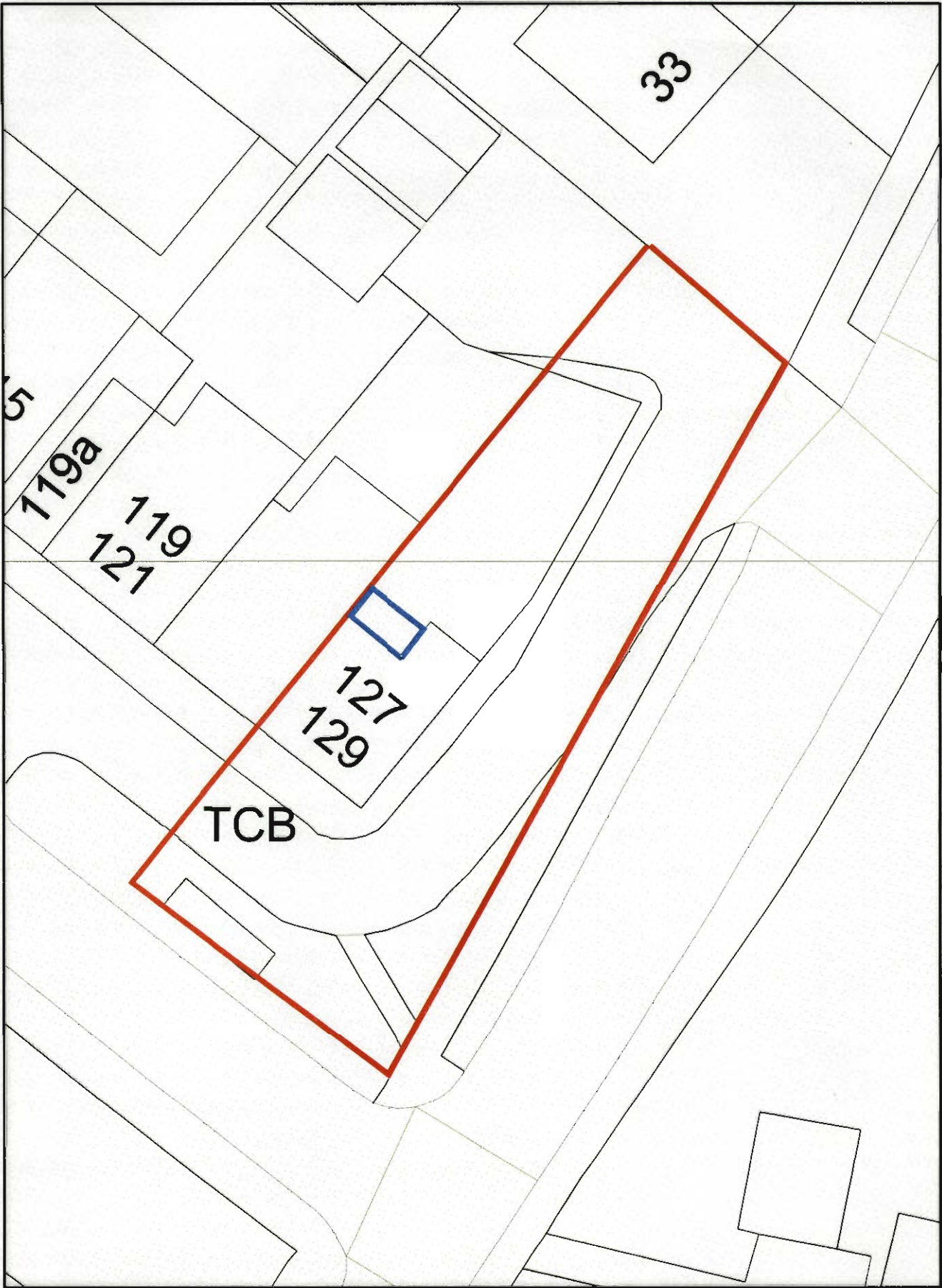
ANNEX

Your Right of Appeal

You can appeal against this notice, but any appeal must be received, or posted in time to be received, by the Secretary of State before the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice. The enclosed information sheet and information in the letter give details of your rights of appeal.

What Happens If You Do Not Appeal

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
