1. This Notice is issued by the council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, within paragraph (a) of section 171A(1) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. The Land To Which The Notice Relates

Land at rear of Hoofprints Lye Lane Bricket Wood St.Albans Hertfordshire Shown edged red on the attached plan.

3. The Matters Which Appear To Constitute The Breach Of Planning Control

It appears to the Council that the following breach of planning control has occurred within the last 4 years.

The laying of hardcore on the land without permission.

4. Reasons For Issuing This Notice

The hardcore which has been laid is an inappropriate form of development in the Green Belt. The hardcore is detrimental to the open character and appearance of the locality, harms the openness of this part of the Green Belt and represents a significant encroachment into the countryside. The development is contrary to Policy 1 (Metropolitan Green Belt) of the St.Albans District Plan Review 1994 and the National Planning Policy Framework 2012.

5. What You Are Required To Do

1. Remove the hardcore from the land in its entirety and

2. Reinstate the land in grass following compliance with requirement 1.

6. Time For Compliance

3 months after this notice takes effect.
