



The St. Albans Rural District Council (Saberton Close, Redbourn) Tree Preservation Order

I refer to the above Tree Preservation Order which has been made by the St. Albans Rural District Council and write to inform you that I support the action taken to preserve the trees which I believe to be an asset to the community.

However, I would like the Secretary of State to consider whether he could confirm the Order in such a manner that, in relation to the trees within the area Gl on the plan annexed to the Order, I and succeeding owners may know precisely which trees on this land are affected. As the Order stands, it is impossible to say which trees on my land are covered by the Order without making a physical inspection of the trees on all the neighbouring land, thereby enabling a comparison to be made between the firees listed in the Order and the neighbouring trees. Thus, by elimination, it would be possible to identify the trees in which I am interested. A knowledge of trees, albeit elementary, is therefore necessary and it seems desirable that a lay person should know precisely how his trees are affected particularly where, as in Saberton Close, there are many other trees, shrubs and bushes.

If my suggestion, which I think would benefit the adjoining owners as well, cannot be adopted I accept the position.


