Failure to do so results in an approval being granted automatically. Non Material Amendment applications should be determined within 28 days.

These notifications are a matter of law and are assessed solely against the relevant part of planning legislation. The law only allows consideration of a small, limited number of technical matters.

In the case of tree work Conservation Area Notice applications, these must be determined within 6 weeks after receipt date as approval exists by default after this Notice period. Conservation Area Notices can only be refused if the Council serves a Tree Preservation Order to protect the affected trees.
