Horse Chestnut (Aesculus Hippocastanum) St Stephen's Parochial Church Council are applying for permission to fell a veteran Horse Chestnut tree (Aesculus Hippocastanum) in the graveyard which following professional advice and an ecological survey has been confirmed as being in rapid decline. It presents an unacceptable level of risk to the public using footpaths through the graveyard and passing along a busy section of Watling Street, 11 metres to the south-west. It is recommended in the attached report from Greenwillows Associates, arboricultural and ecological surveyors, that the tree should be felled within six months with high priority, and that the work should be carried out as soon as possible, partly to enable 'a safer dismantlement of the tree and partly to enable the work to be carried out at the most appropriate time, following the advice of the ecologist's report, in early March 2024. The attached Bat Letter Report from Greenwillows Associates explains the methodology and the findings of the ecological survey; pages 3-5 present the conclusions which outline the procedure for felling the tree (a 'soft fell') after a 'follow-up PRF inspection' supervised by a qualified ecologist, to identify if any bat roosts or nesting birds are present. The timing of early March is important since this will be after the bat winter hibernation period and before bat maternity colonies form in May/August, and also the jackdaw nesting season, mid-March/April. A sketch plan of the churchyard is also attached with the location of the tree marked. A replacement for the horse chestnut tree was planted approx. 20 years ago nearby in the churchyard, but the PCC are also considering an additional tree close to the location of the Horse Chestnut tree to be felled, if a suitable position can be found. at St Stephens Church Watling Street St Albans Hertfordshire AL1 2PT

Failure to do so results in an approval being granted automatically. Non Material Amendment applications should be determined within 28 days.

These notifications are a matter of law and are assessed solely against the relevant part of planning legislation. The law only allows consideration of a small, limited number of technical matters.

In the case of tree work Conservation Area Notice applications, these must be determined within 6 weeks after receipt date as approval exists by default after this Notice period. Conservation Area Notices can only be refused if the Council serves a Tree Preservation Order to protect the affected trees.
